Belivery Method Learning Outcomes Description

Learners will need to demonstrate that they can identify hazards and risks associated with the workplace and understand the processes and procedures that must be followed to mitigate risks, prevent accidents. They will carry out and document a risk assessment. They will carry out a simple risk assessment in the workplace and identify aspects of environmental responsibility in their own organisation.

- Understand the organisation's policy and responsibilities for ensuring a safe and healthy Working environment
- Understand own responsibilities for health and safety in the workplace
- understand how risk assessments contribute to health and safety
- Understand how to identify and control the risks from common workplace hazards
- Know the procedures for responding to accidents and incidents in the workplace
